STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide for the Disposition of Moneys Received from the White Mountain Forest Reserve under an Act of Congress of May Twenty-three, Nineteen Hundred and Eight.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. All sums of money heretofore received and
2 hereafter to be received into the treasury of this state from
3 the White Mountain Forest Reserve, so-called, under the
4 provisions of an Act of Congress, approved May twenty5 three, nineteen hundred and eight, providing that twenty6 five per centum of the money received from each national
7 forest reserve during each fiscal year shall be paid by the

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8 secretary of the treasury to the state in which said reserve 9 is situated, to be expended as the legislature of each state 10 may prescribe for the benefit of the public roads of the 11 county or counties in which the forest reserve is situated, 12 shall be transferred to the county treasurer of Oxford 13 county.

Sect. 2. The county commissioners of Oxford county are 2 hereby authorized to expend said sums so transferred to 3 them under the provisions of section one on the public roads 4 of the county of Oxford, in such manner as they shall judge 5 to be for the best interests of said county.
