STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Four of Chapter Thirteen of the
Revised Statutes, Relating to Vacancies in the Office of
County Treasurer Filled by Appointment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes is
2 hereby amended by striking out all after the word "treas-
3 urer" in the fifth line thereof, and adding thereto instead
4 the following: 'until the first day of January following the
5 next biennial election, at which said election a treasurer
6 shall be chosen for the remainder of the term, if any; but
7 in any event he shall hold office until another is chosen and

8 qualified'; so that said section, as amended, shall read as
9 follows:

'Sect. 4. If a person so chosen declines to accept, or a
2 vacancy occurs, the governor, with the advice and consent
3 of the council, may appoint a suitable resident of the county,
4 who, having accepted the trust, given bond, and been sworn,
5 shall be treasurer until the first day of January following
6 the next biennial election, at which said election a treasurer
7 shall be chosen for the remainder of the term, if any; but
8 in any event he shall hold office until another is chosen and
9 qualified.'
