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AN ACT to Ratify, Confirm and Make Valid the Doings of the Old Folks' Home, in Bath, and the Home for Aged Couples and Old Men, in Consolidating the Homes for the Aged Maintained by Them Severally.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All the corporate acts and proceedings of the Old Folks' Home, in Bath, and all the corporate acts and proceedings of the Home for Aged Couples and Old Men; done, transacted and performed in effecting the consolidation and union of the homes for the aged formerly maintained by each of said corporations, severally; and all grants, conveyances, assignments and transfers of its properties and funds, real and personal, by said Home for Aged Couples and Old
