STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Ratify, Confirm and Make Valid the Doings of the O'd Folks' Home, in Bath, and the Home for Aged Couples and Old Men, in Consolidating the Homes for the Aged Maintained by Them Severally.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Ail the corporate acts and proceedings of the Old Folks'
2 Home, in Bath, and all the corporate acts and proceedings
3 of the Home for Aged Couples and Old Men; done, trans4 acted and performed in effecting the consolidation and union
5 of the homes for the aged formerly maintained by each of
6 said corporations, severally; and all grants, conveyances.
7 assignments and transfers of its properties and funds, real
8 and personal, by said Home for Aged Couples and Old

9 Men to said Old Folks' Home, in Bath, in connection with 10 or ancillary to said consolidation and merger, are hereby 11 ratified, confirmed and made valid.
