RESOLVE, to Appropriate Money for the Purchase of a History of York.

Resolved: That fifty copies of the "History of York, 2 the First English City on This Continent," by Edward C. 3 Moody, be purchased by the state at a cost of two dollars 4 per copy. The copies so purchased shall be distributed in 5 high schools or elsewhere at the discretion of the state libra-6 rian, or library commission. .

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Seventy-ninth legislature passed a Resolve providing for the purchase of one hundred and twenty-five copies to be distributed in the high schools of the state and elsewhere, at the discretion of the librarian. The supply is inadequate as there are more than one hundred and seventy-five high schools in the state.
