## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, In Favor of the Town of Old Orchard.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for 2 the improvement of the so-called Cascade road in the town 3 of Old Orchard, five thousand dollars for the year of nine-4 teen hundred and twenty-one and five thousand dollars 5 for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-two, provided 6 that there be furnished by the town of Old Orchard five 7 thousand dollars for the year of nineteen hundred and 8 twenty-one and five thousand dollars for the year of nine-9 teen hundred and twenty-two for the same purpose. •

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The road leading from state aid highway about one-half mile from Old Orchard town hall and extending to Maine state highway, on which the appropriation is asked for, is a very heavily traveled road, used by local people, in the town of Old Orchard, and surrounding towns and also by summer tourists coming and leaving Old Orchard. This road is the most direct road leading from Old Orchard to the State highway running from Boston to Portland.
