## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a Weir in the Tidewaters of Roque Harbor in the Town of Jonesport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Oscar W. Look of Jonesport, in the county of
2 Washington, is hereby authorized to build and maintain a
3 weir for fishing purposes in the tide-waters of Roque Har4 bor in said Jonesport, providing said weir does not inter5 fere with navigation or the rights of others.

Sect. 2. The above mentioned weir shall be located as 2 follows: The pound or weir will face the north-west and 3 have a swing of twenty fathoms, and shall be located south-4 west of Seal rock between the first twenty-four and twenty-

5 five foot mark on chart number three hundred and four, and 6 the easterly wing to be seventy-five fathoms long running 7 north north-east from the pound of said weir. And the 8 westerly wing to be eighty-five fathoms long, running west 9 north-west toward the high head at the west end of Roque 10 Island beach.
