STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a Weir in Tide Waters of What Was Formerly Muscle Ridge Plantation in the County of Knox.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Wm. Underwood Company, a corporation

- 2 duly organized and existing by law, and assigns are hereby
- 3 authorized to build and maintain a fish weir in the tide
- 4 waters of what was formerly Muscle Ridge Plantation in
- 5 the county of Knox; provided said weir does not interfere
- 6 with navigation or with the rights of others.

Sect. 2. The above mentioned weir shall be located as

- 2 follows, to wit, the pound is to be located about five hun-
- 3 dred feet, west by south-three quarters south from Dix

- 4 Island, and to be about six hundred feet in circumference,
- 5 with one leader extending east by north-three quarters north,
- 6 four hundred feet, and one leader extending north by east,
- 7 two hundred feet. With pocket to be attached to the north
- 8 side of said pound and to be about sixty feet square.
