STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Ducks and Geese in the
Waters of Merrymeeting Bay and Its Tributaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No blind, or artificial cover, used for gunning purposes
2 on any boat or float shall be left or allowed to remain in
3 the waters of Merrymeeting Bay in the counties of Cumber-
4 land and Sagadahoc, or in the tributaries thereof, between
5 sunset and one-half hour before sunrise.
