**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

RESOLVE, in Favor of Manzie I. Rogers for Building High-
ways in the Town of Searsport.

Resolved: That the state treasurer be and hereby is au-
2 thorized and directed to pay to Manzie I. Rogers the sum
3 of one thousand dollars for the building of two and fifty-
4 three hundredths miles of highway in the town of Searsport,
5 Waldo county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Manzie I. Rogers of Bangor contracted to build state highway "L" Searsport, two and fifty-three hundredths miles. Work commenced in nineteen hundred and fifteen, and was eighty per cent completed. At request of commission work to be resumed about May fifteenth, nineteen hundred and sixteen. Without just cause, or for causes beyond his control, the work was taken out of his hands by commission, and commission agreed to complete the remainder of highway with profit to contractor, which it failed to do. Mr. Rogers now seeks at the hands of legislature not only for one thousand one hundred and twenty-two dollars and fourteen cents reserved and withheld by commission, but also for necessary expenses and reasonable profit promised.
