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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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RESOLVE, Authorizing F. Burton Haggett and Lawrence B.  
Haggett to Bring a Suit at Law Against the State of Maine.

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Resolved: That, F. Burton Haggett and Lawrence B. Hag-  
2 gett, both of Wiscasset in the county of Lincoln and state  
3 of Maine, co-partners in trade under the name of Hag-  
4 getts' Garage Company, being the owners of a certain auto-  
5 mobile which was being driven along the public highway  
6 in said county on June fourth, nineteen hundred and twenty,  
7 and which met with an accident and came into collision  
8 with a state highway truck owned and operated by the state  
9 highway department, which highway truck was insured by

10 the state highway department against all claims for dam-  
11 ages due to collision and accident with the Automobile Mu-  
12 tual Liability Insurance Company and which collision and  
13 accident caused damage to the said Haggetts' car, said Hag-  
14 getts are hereby authorized to bring suit at law in the su-  
15 preme judicial court within one year from the first day of  
16 June, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, at any term day  
17 thereof for the county of Lincoln against the state of Maine  
18 and the writ issuing out of said supreme judicial court  
19 under the authority of this resolve shall be served on the  
20 secretary of state by attested copy thirty days before the  
21 return day thereof by the sheriff or either of his deputies  
22 of any county of the state of Maine, and the conduct of  
23 said suit shall be according to the practice of suits between  
24 parties and suitors in the said supreme judicial court and  
25 the liabilities of the parties shall be the same as the liabili-  
26 ties between individuals, and as if the accident had occurred  
27 between individuals; and the attorney general or counsel  
28 for the Automobile Mutual Liability Insurance Company  
29 is hereby authorized to appear in answer to said suit to  
30 recover damages sustained by the said Haggetts by reason  
31 of said accident and any judgment that may be recovered  
32 in such suit at law shall be payable from the treasury of  
33 the state of Maine on final process issued by said supreme  
34 judicial court in said suit at law out of any money not  
35 otherwise appropriated and costs may be taxed for the said  
36 Haggetts if they recover in said suit.
