STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Additional to Chapter Twenty of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Sale of Poisons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter twenty of the revised statutes is hereby amended

2 by adding to said chapter the three following sections:

'Sect. 31. Any firm, person or corporation that sells or
2 has in his possession for sale medicated alcohol shall affix
3 to the container thereof a label in the following form:
"Medicated Alcohol

Poison—For external use only. This alcohol is medicated 2 in conformity with formula No.... approved by the U. S. 3 internal revenue department for rendering alcohol unfit for 4 beverage purposes. The ingredients, while making the alco-5 hol acceptable for external application, render it positively6 dangerous for internal administration."

Sect. 32. The possession of any container of alcohol which 2 has not affixed to it a label as above provided shall be prima 3 facie evidence that said alcohol is not medicated.

Sect. 33. Any person, firm or corporation who fails to 2 comply with the provisions of section thirty-one shall be 3 punished for each offense by a fine not exceeding one hun-4 dred dollars or by two months in jail or both.'

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
