STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT Authorizing the Orono Pulp and Paper Company
to Erect and Maintain Booms and Piers at and Near Bunker
Landing on the Passadumkeag River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Orono Pulp and Paper Company, a cor-
2 poration duly existing under the laws of the state of Maine,
3 its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized and em-
4 powered to locate, erect and maintain at or near Bunker
5 Landing on the Passadumkeag river, all in the county of
6 Penobscot, piers and booms for the collecting and holding
7 of logs and pulpwood, and for the separating and sorting
8 of this company's logs and pulpwood from logs, pulpwood

9 and lumber of other persons or corporations, coming into
10 the waters of said river. Such piers and booms shall be
11 so located, erected and maintained, and sorting gaps and
12 trip booms shall be so constructed that logs, pulpwood and
13 lumber of other persons or corporations shall not be un-
14 reasonably delayed or impeded. Such logs, pulpwood and
15 lumber of other persons or corporations when stopped for
16 sorting shall be turned by as soon as the same can be prac-
17 tically separated from logs and pulpwood of this company.
18 Said company shall leave open a sufficient width of stream
19 to float logs and wood not required to be sorted. Forty-
20 eight hours after any logs come into the confines of said
21 booms and piers, built under this charter, they shall be sorted
22 by said Orono Pulp and Paper Company and turned down
23 said stream.

Sect. 2. The Passadumkeag Log Driving Company, a cor-
2 poration duly existing under the laws of Maine, may at
3 any time appoint an agent to superintend the sorting of
4 logs and pulpwood passing through the booms and sorting
5 gaps herein authorized and may, if necessary, employ ad-
6 ditional men to assist in sorting and said Orono Pulp and
7 Paper Company and other owners at the time of the ap-
8 pointment of such agent shall furnish such agent a list of
9 marks upon all logs and pulpwood intended to be used by
10 them at mills or elsewhere, and such agent shall see to it
11 that logs and pulpwood not the property of this company
12 or destined for its use shall not be unreasonably detained

13 in or by said booms. The compensation of such agent and
14 of such additional men shall be paid by the said Passa-
15 dumkeag Log Driving Company and reimbursed to that
16 company by the said Orono Pulp and Paper Company.

Sect. 3. Any stray logs or pulpwood not belonging to said
2 Orono Pulp and Paper Company found in the booms afore-
3 said, shall be turned out by said Orono Pulp and Paper
4 Company at its expense on written demand from the owners
5 thereof. If any stray logs come into the confines of the
6 booms and piers constructed under this act after the gen-
7 eral sorting and turning out of said logs said Orono Pulp
8 and Paper Company shall hold said logs in a careful man-
9 ner until the next drive or sorting.
