STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-seven of Chapter Twentyfour of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Appropriation for the Abolishment of Grade Crossings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section thirty-seven of chapter twenty-four of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "year"
3 in the second line thereof the words, 'except as herein pro4 vided,' by striking out in the second line the word "fifteen"
5 and inserting in place thereof the word 'ten,' and by adding
6 at the end of said section the following paragraph:

"The amounts to be appropriated under the provisions of 2 this section shall be cumulative and any part of said sum

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3 of ten thousand dollars not expended during the year for 4 which it is appropriated shall, at the close of said year, be 5 added to the sums subsequently appropriated, and may be 6 expended in any subsequent year or years'; so that said 7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 37. The amount to be paid under the provisions 2 of the three preceding sections by the state in any one year, 3 except as herein provided, shall not exceed ten thousand 4 dollars, and said sum shall be annually appropriated. The 5 amounts to be appropriated under the provisions of this 6 section shall be cumulative and any part of said sum of 7 ten thousand dollars not expended during the year for which 8 it is appropriated shall, at the close of said year, be added 9 to the sums subsequently appropriated, and may be expended 10 in any subsequent year or years.'

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
