**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred and Three of Chap-  
ter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to State Aid  
to Academies.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred and three of chapter sixteen of the  
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by substituting the word  
3 'three' for the word "two" in the third line thereof, the  
4 word 'two' for the word "one" in the sixth line thereof,  
5 and the word 'three' for the word "two" in the ninth line  
6 thereof, so that said section when amended shall read as  
7 follows:

‘Sect. 103. No academy shall receive state aid under section ninety-eight if said academy has an annual income from invested funds exceeding three thousand dollars; and no academy shall receive state aid to exceed five hundred dollars in any given year provided the said academy has an annual income from invested funds exceeding two thousand dollars; provided, however, that any academy with a larger average attendance than two hundred shall receive such aid not to exceed one thousand dollars if its annual income from invested funds, after deducting interest paid on its indebtedness, does not exceed three thousand dollars.’
