# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Reimbursing the St. Mary's General Hospital of Lewiston for Services Rendered in the Care of Certain Patients During the Calendar Year Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen.

Resolved: That there be paid to St. Mary's General Hos-2 pital, for services rendered during the year nineteen hun-3 dred and nineteen, under the provisions of chapter one hun-4 dred and thirteen of the resolves of nineteen hundred and 5 nineteen, the sum of seven hundred and sixty-eight dollars 6 and fifty-six cents (\$768.56).

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This hospital received an appropriation from the 79th legislature, to be applied to the care of poor persons requiring hospital treatment and being unable to pay for it. The appropriation amounted to six thousand dollars. Bills were rendered to the state and paid to the amount of \$5,241.44. The unexpended balance has lapsed to the state contingent fund. The hospital has now filed with the state board of charities and corrections, proper evidence that further services, properly chargeable to said appropriation, sufficient to absorb the balance, were rendered. This claim is made to the 80th legislature, in order that the state auditor may have authority to allow, and the state treasurer to pay, the aforesaid balance.
