**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-three of Chapter Two of
the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Appointment of Dedi-
mus Justices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-three of chapter two of the revised statutes
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "persons"
3 in the second line thereof the words, 'who shall be desig-
4 nated as dedimus justices'; so that said section, as amended,
5 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 43. The governor, with the advice and consent of
2 the council, may appoint in every county, persons who shall
3 be designated as dedimus justices, before whom the oath,
4 required by the constitution to qualify civil officers, may be

5 taken and subscribed. Such persons shall exercise their
6 powers and duties, and shall be commissioned to act within
7 and for every county. This section shall apply to such
8 persons appointed and commissioned prior to the thirtieth
9 day of June, nineteen hundred and eleven, and shall validate
10 any acts theretofore or thereafter done by them which would
11 be valid hereunder.'
