STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, Prohibiting the Manufacture of Intoxicating Liquors, so that Said Chapter Will Be in Harmony with the Federal Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section seventeen of chapter one hundred and twenty-sev2 en of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out
3 all of said section and substituting in place thereof the fol4 lowing:

'Sect. 17. Whoever manufactures or attempts to manu-2 facture any intoxicating liquors, except cider, and whoever 3 has in his possession any wort or mash fit for distillation or 4 for the production of distilled spirits, or has in his posses-

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5 sion any worm, still or other device for the purpose of 6 manufacturing intoxicating liquors, shall be imprisoned for 7 two months and fined one thousand dollars; and said wort, 8 mash, worm, still or other device shall be seized by any of-9 ficer having authority to seize intoxicating liquors and shall 10 be declared forfeited by the court or magistrate having cog 11 nizance of the case, and ordered destroyed.'
