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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT Additional to and Amendatory of Chapter Thirty-  
two of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter One  
Hundred and Eighty-five of the Public Laws of Nineteen  
Hundred and Nineteen Relative to the Licensing of Public  
Exhibitions and Amusements.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes as amended by  
2 chapter one hundred eighty-five of the public laws of nine-  
3 ten hundred and nineteen is hereby further amended by  
4 adding thereto the following:

'Sect. 25. County commissioners, within their counties,

2 and counties, within their limits, shall respectively exercise  
3 over unincorporated places all the powers of municipal offi-  
4 cers and towns under this chapter.'
