STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Stephen Blaisdell for Materials Furnished in the Construction of the Central School Building for the Maine State School for Girls.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of two hundred six dollars and eighty-eight cents
3 (\$206.88) to be paid to Stephen Blaisdell of Belgrade, Maine,
4 for material furnished by him in the construction of the
5 Central School building for girls at Hallowell.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The supplies were furnished to the contractors, Alfred Hanson & Son of Augusta, and the balance, amounting to \$206.88, was never paid to Mr. Blaisdell. The facts are practically the same as those in connection with a similar resolve, now before the committee on claims, in favor of Frank S. Wingate (House Document No. 6).
