STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Ten of Chapter One Hundred and Twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Unauthorized Use of Insignia of War Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ten of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended, so that said section,
3 as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Whoever wilfully wears the badge, button or other in-
2 signia of the Grand Army of the Republic, of the Sons of
3 Veterans, of the United Spanish War Veterans, of the Vet-
4 erans of Foreign Wars, or of the American Legion, or the
5 official discharge button of the army, navy or marine corps,

6 or uses or wears the same to obtain aid or assistance thereby
7 within the state, unless he shall be entitled to use or wear
8 the same under the rules and regulations respectively of
9 the Department of Maine of the Grand Army of the Re-
10 public, of the Sons of Veterans, of the United Spanish War
11 Veterans, of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, or of the Amer-
12 ican Legion, or under the regulations of the army, navy or
13 marine corps, shall be punished by imprisonment for not
14 more than thirty days, or by fine not exceeding twenty dol-
15 lars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
