STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize Establishment of Danger Signals on Public Ways, and to Regulate Display of Advertisements Thereon.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The state highway commission may authorize and regulate 2 the display of suitable advertisements upon approved high-3 way danger signals placed at curves, intersecting ways and 4 other places of danger along the highways by order or per-5 mit of the commission. Whoever wantonly injures or re-6 moves any such signal, its light or mechanism, or defaces

7 any marks or lettering thereon, shall be punished as pro-

8 vided in section twenty-four of chapter one hundred and 9 twenty-nine of the revised statutes relating to malicious in-10 jury to monuments.
