STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Governor and Council to Adjust Claims for Damages Caused by Flowage on Indian Island in the Penobscot River.

Resolved: That the governor and council be and hereby 2 are authorized and empowered to adjust all claims for dam-3 ages to lands, highways and bridges on Indian Island, or 4 Island Number One, so-called, in the Penobscot river, oc-5 casioned by flowage of the same by the Bangor Railway and 6 Electric Company, and all sums received in settlement there-7 for are hereby appropriated, in addition to all other appro-8 priations, for the purpose of maintenance and repair of 9 highways, and bridges on said Island for the benefit of the 10 Penobscot Tribe of Indians.
