## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Payment of Certain Deficiencies.

Whereas, the various deficiency items comprised in this resolve are long overdue and further delay in the payment thereof will occasion great inconvenience to many departments of the state government and to citizens of the state; and

Whereas, in the opinion of the legislature these facts constitute this resolve an emergency measure, which is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, now therefore,

Resolved, that the sum of twenty thousand six hundred 2 and thirteen dollars and twenty-nine cents be appropriated 3 to pay such deficiencies, as shown in a list presented to the

4 legislature by the state auditor on January twenty-eighth.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this resolve 2 shall take effect when approved.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The claims covered by this resolve were duly advertised and hearing had thereon, at which the auditor and others were present and after hearing thereon and consideration thereof the committee recommend the adoption and passage of this resolve for the amount above named.
