**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Retracing and Defining of the Lines of the Public Lots.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-five hundred dollars; five hundred dollars
3 for the six months ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
4 and twenty-one, one thousand dollars for the year ending
5 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two and one
6 thousand dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nine-
7 teen hundred and twenty-three, for the purpose of retrac-
8 ing and defining the lines of the public lots in the state of
9 Maine; said fund to be expended under the direction of the
10 forest commissioner.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State owns in many townships the soil of lots heretofore set off and designated as Public Lots, the lines of which are becoming obliterated. This appropriation is for the purpose of remarking the lines of said lots, and for the locating and marking of such lots as have not heretofore been set off.
