STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Superintendent of Public Buildings for Salary and Wages and for Maintenance and Improvements.

Resolved: That there be appropriated for the superin-2 tendent of public buildings for salary and wages, for main-3 tenance and improvements, as follows:

For salary and wages, for the period from January first, 2 nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June thirtieth, nineteen 3 hundred and twenty-one, the sum of seventeen thousand 4 dollars (\$17,000); for the year from July first, nineteen hun-5 dred and twenty-one to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and 6 twenty-two, the sum of thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,-

7 000); and for the year from July first, nineteen hundred 8 and twenty-two to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and 9 twenty-three, the sum of thirty-two thousand dollars 10 (\$32,000).

For maintenance and improvements, for the period from 2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June 3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of 4 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000); for the year from July 5 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June thirtieth, 6 nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum of thirty-eight 7 thousand dollars (\$38,000); and for the year from July 8 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two to June thirtieth, 9 nineteen hundred and twenty-three, the sum of thirty-eight 10 thousand dollars (\$38,000).
