STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Purchase Five Hundred Copies of the "Public Letters of John Fairfield."

Whereas, the fiscal year of the State of Maine now ends on June thirtieth instead of December thirty-first of each year, and no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year 1921, and whereas, appropriation for the purchase of five hundred copies of the "Public Letters of John Fairfield" is an emergency measure, now therefore,

Resolved: That there be appropriated for the period from 2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June 3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of two 4 thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the purchase of five hundred 5 copies of the "Public Letters of John Fairfield." The same 6 is to be under direction of the State Librarian.
