RESOLVE, Providing for the Care, Support and Medical or Surgical Treatment of Dependent Persons in or by Certain Charitable and Benevolent Institutions and Organizations not Owned or Controlled by the State, and for Other Purposes.

Whereas, no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and whereas, appropriation for the institutions named below is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore,

Resolved: That there be appropriated for the period from
2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June
3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of
4 ninety-four thousand five hundred dollars (\$94,500), for the
5 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to
6 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum
7 of one hundred eighty-nine thousand dollars (\$189,000),
8 and for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and
9 twenty-two to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-
10 three, the sum of one hundred eighty-one thousand five hun-
11 dred dollars (\$181,500), for the necessary care and medical
12 or surgical treatment, at the rates specified and in or by the
13 institutions and organizations named, of certain classes of
14 persons whose own resources, or the resources of whose
15 responsible relatives as defined by section eighteen of chap-
16 ter twenty-nine of the revised statutes, are insufficient to
17 pay for the same, and for other purposes, namely:

For the care and support of children under sixteen years
2 of age, including those supported away from their parents
3 under the provisions of sections fifty-one to fifty-five inclu-
4 sive, chapter sixty-four, revised statutes, and acts amenda-
