IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Northern Cumberland

Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter forty-eight of the private and
2 special laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "six" in the second line
4 of said section and inserting in place thereof the word
5 'eight,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as fol6 lows:

'Sect. 16. Salary of judge and recorder. The judge of 2 said court shall receive the salary of eight hundred dollars 3 per year, to be paid in equal quarterly payments from the 4 county treasury of Cumberland county, which shall be in

5 full for his services as such judge, except as hereinbefore 6 provided. The recorder shall receive a salary of one hun-7 dred dollars per year, payable in the same manner as that 8 of the judge.'
