STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Sixteen of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter One Hundred and Ninety-six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen to Increase the Salary of the State Treasurer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter one hundred and seventeen of
the revised statutes as amended by chapter one hundred
and ninety-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
seventeen is hereby amended so that said section shall read
as follows:

'Sect. 16. The treasurer of state shall receive an annual 2 salary of three thousand dollars; he shall receive no other 3 fee, emolument or perquisite.

The chief clerk in the office of the treasurer of state shall 2 be designated as "deputy treasurer of state" and his salary 3 shall be fixed in accordance with chapter two hundred and 4 fifteen, section one, of the public laws of nineteen hundred 5 and nineteen.'
