STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Ten of Chapter Two Hundred Ninety-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen Relating to the Per Diem of Sea and Shore Fisheries Wardens,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Amend section ten of chapter two hundred ninety-three
2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen by
3 striking out the word "three" in the fifth line and inserting
4 in place thereof the word 'four,' so that said section as
5 amended shall read as follows:

'Fish wardens shall receive such compensation as the di-2 rector of sea and shore fisheries may determine, not to ex3 ceed four dollars per day when actually engaged in the per-4 formance of their duties, provided that they may receive5 their expenses properly incurred while so engaged.'

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
