NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT to Amend Section Ten of Chapter Two Hundred  
Ninety-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seven-  
teen Relating to the Per Diem of Sea and Shore Fisheries  
Wardens.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Amend section ten of chapter two hundred ninety-three  
2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen by  
3 striking out the word "three" in the fifth line and inserting  
4 in place thereof the word 'four,' so that said section as  
5 amended shall read as follows:

'Fish wardens shall receive such compensation as the di-  
2 rector of sea and shore fisheries may determine, not to ex-

3 ceed four dollars per day when actually engaged in the per-  
4 formance of their duties, provided that they may receive  
5 their expenses properly incurred while so engaged.'
