**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Eleven of Chapter Two Hundred Sixty of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen, Increasing the Salary of the Stenographer of the Androscoggin Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter two hundred and sixty of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby
3 amended by striking out in the seventh line thereof the
4 word "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof the word
5 'eighteen'; so that said section, as amended, shall read as
6 follows:

‘Sect. 11. The justice of said court may appoint a stenog-
2 rapher to report the proceedings thereof, who shall be an
3 officer of the court and be sworn to a faithful discharge of
4 his duty, and who shall perform the duties prescribed and
5 be subject to the provisions of the revised statutes, chapter
6 eighty-seven, sections one hundred and sixty-seven to one
7 hundred and seventy-two inclusive, so far as the same may
8 be applicable. The salary of said stenographer shall be
9 eighteen hundred dollars annually, to be paid quarterly from
10 the treasury of the county.’
