STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Five of Chapter One Hundred and Twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Removal or Concealment of Mortgaged or Attached Personal Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of

the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after

the word "property" in the second line of said section, the

words 'or personal property legally attached on original

writ,' and the words 'or the attaching officer' after the word

mortgagee" in the second line of said section, so that said

section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Whoever with fraudulent intent to place mort2 gaged personal property, or property legally attached on
3 original writ beyond the control of the mortgagee or the
4 attaching officer, removes or conceals, or aids or abets in
5 removing or concealing the same, and any mortgagor of
6 such property, who assents to such removal or concealment,
7 shall be punished by fine not exceeding one thousand dol8 lars, or by imprisonment not exceeding one year.'
