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**STATE OF MAINE**

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT to Amend Section Five of Chapter One Hundred  
and Twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Re-  
moval or Concealment of Mortgaged or Attached Personal  
Property.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of  
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "property" in the second line of said section, the  
4 words 'or personal property legally attached on original  
5 writ,' and the words 'or the attaching officer' after the word  
6 "mortgagee" in the second line of said section, so that said  
7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Whoever with fraudulent intent to place mort-  
2 gaged personal property, or property legally attached on  
3 original writ beyond the control of the mortgagee or the  
4 attaching officer, removes or conceals, or aids or abets in  
5 removing or concealing the same, and any mortgagor of  
6 such property, who assents to such removal or concealment,  
7 shall be punished by fine not exceeding one thousand dol-  
8 lars, or by imprisonment not exceeding one year.'
