**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT Additional to Chapter Thirty-three of the Revised Statutes, as Amended, Relating to the Protection of White Perch in East Pond and in North Pond of the Belgrade Chain of Lakes, So-called, in Kennebec County and in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any family, party or
2 the occupants of any one boat, canoe, raft or other vessel
3 or conveyance to take, catch, kill or to have in possession
4 in any one day more than forty white perch in all in East
5 pond or in North pond, of the Belgrade Chain of Lakes,
6 so-called, in Kennebec county and in Somerset county.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more
3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and one dollar
4 additional for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in pos-
5 session in violation of this act.
