# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Purpose of Operating the Fish Hatcheries and Feeding Stations for Fish, for the Protection of Fish, Game and Birds, and for Printing the Report of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, and other Expenses Incident to the Administration of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred and forty-five 2 thousand dollars (\$245,000) be, and hereby is, appropriated, 3 as follows: Forty-nine thousand dollars (\$49,000) for 4 the period between January first and June thirtieth, nine-5 teen hundred and twenty-one; ninety-eight thousand dollars 6 (\$98,000) for the period between July first, nineteen hun-

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7 dred and twenty-one, and June thirtieth, nineteen hundred 8 and twenty-two, and ninety-eight thousand dollars (\$98,-9 000) for the period between July first, nineteen hundred 10 and twenty-two, and June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and 11 twenty-three, to be expended by the commissioner of in-12 land fisheries and game, for the purpose of operating the 13 fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish in the state, for 14 the protection of fish, game and birds, for printing the re-15 port of the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, for 16 maintenance of the state museum, payment of bounties on 17 bob cats killed in this state and other expenses incident to 18 the administration of the department of inland fisheries and 19 game, and that any of this appropriation unexpended at 20 the end of either year shall be available for the following 21 year.
