STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Three Hundred and Nineteen, of
the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen, and Acts
Amendatory Thereof, Providing for State and County Aid
in the Construction of Highway Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter three hundred and nineteen of
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, as modified
3 by section three, of chapter two hundred and fifty-one, of
4 the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby
5 amended by striking out all of said section after the word
6 "appropriated" in the third line thereof and inserting in
7 place thereof the words: 'seven hundred thousand dollars
8 from the proceeds of bridge bonds authorized and issued

9 in nineteen hundred and twenty-one, nineteen hundred and
10 twenty-two and nineteen hundred and twenty-three; mean-
11 ing hereby to constitute said amounts, together with any
12 unexpended balance remaining in the account set up by
13 authority of section three, of chapter two hundred and
14 fifty-one, public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, a
15 continuous carrying account, and said sums are hereby ap-
16 propriated to meet expenses of new construction'; so that
17 as amended said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 11. To meet the financial obligations of the state to
2 be incurred under the provisions of this act there shall be
3 appropriated seven hundred thousand dollars from the pro-
4 ceeds of bridge bonds authorized and issued in nineteen
5 hundred and twenty-one, nineteen hundred and twenty-two
6 and nineteen hundred and twenty-three; meaning hereby
7 to constitute said amounts, together with any unexpended
8 balance remaining in the account set up by authority of
9 section three, of chapter two hundred and fifty-one, public
10 laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, a continuous carry-
11 ing account, and said sums are hereby appropriated to meet
12 expenses of new construction.'
