**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Augusta State Hospital for
Furniture and Other Equipment.

Whereas, the new female pavilion or wing of the Augusta State Hospital has been completed, and,

Whereas, equipment and furniture is immediately necessary to place this wing of said Augusta State Hospital in operation, and,

Whereas, legislation to equip said wing is immediately necessary in the interests of the public peace, health and safety, and,

Whereas, the foregoing facts in the judgment of this Legislature constitute an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of this State, now therefore;

Be is Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated
2 for the Augusta State Hospital:

For furniture and other equipment..... \$8000.00

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve
2 shall take effect when approved.
