RESOLVE, for a Marker for Maine Soldiers at Valley Forge.

Resolved: That the sum of six hundred dollars be, and
2 the same hereby is, appropriated for a Memorial Marker
3 for Maine soldiers at Valley Forge, said sum to be expend-
4 ed by the president of the Maine Society, Sons of the
5 American Revolution, and its executive committee, under
6 the direction of the governor and council.
