STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Five of Chapter One Hundred and Eighty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to the Jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission Over Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter one hundred eighty-four of the 2 public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby

- 3 amended by adding thereto the following: 'and any owner
- 4 or operator of any such motor vehicle convicted of wil-
- 5 fully violating any rule or regulation made by the public
- 6 utilities commission under authority of section two of this
- 7 chapter shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty,

8 nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment 9 for not exceeding sixty days,' so that said section, as 10 amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Any person, firm or corporation operating such 2 motor vehicle or vehicles on any street or highway in any 3 city or town of this state, failing to comply with any rules 4 or regulations made by said public utilities commission 5 shall be subject to the penalties provided in sections sixty-6 three to sixty-seven both inclusive of chapter fifty-five of 7 the revised statutes, and any owner or operator of any such 8 motor vehicle convicted of wilfully violating any rule or 9 regulation made by the public utilities commission under 10 authority of section two of this chapter shall be punished 11 by a fine of not less than fifty, nor more than one hundred 12 dollars, or by imprisonment for not exceeding sixty days.'
