IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Roy L. Fernald in Payment of Counsel Fees and Disbursements Made by Him in the Contested Representative Election Case from the Class Towns of Searsport, Islesboro, Stockton, Prospect, Winterport and Frankfort.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars 2 is hereby appropriated, and that the state treasurer be, and 3 hereby is, authorized and directed to pay said sum of one 4 hundred and fifty dollars to Roy L. Fernald for expenses 5 incurred by him in contesting the seat of Joseph A. Pendle-

6 ton, representative from the class towns of Searsport, Isles-

- 7 boro, Stockton, Prospect, Winterport and Frankfort, in the

STATEMENT OF FACTS
