STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph A. Pendleton, in Payment of Counsel Fees and Disbursements in the Contested Representative Election Case from the Class Towns of Searsport, Islesboro, Stockton, Prospect, Winterport and Frankfort.

Resolved: that the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars 2 is hereby appropriated, and that the state treasurer be, and 3 hereby is, authorized and directed to pay said sum of one 4 hundred and fifty dollars to Joseph A. Pendleton for ex-5 penses incurred by him in contesting his seat as representa-6 tive from the class towns of Searsport, Islesboro, Stockton, 7 Prospect, Winterport and Frankfort, in the contested elec-8 tion case from said class heard before the house committee 9 on elections.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It has been customary in the past for the Legislature to reimburse the parties where a seat in the House or Senate has been contested. The present resolve is intended to reimburse Mr. Pendleton for expenditures incurred in the recent Islesboro Class contest.
