IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Authorizing the Town of Harrison to Raise Money to Build a Clock Tower in Said Town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of Harrison are hereby au-

- 2 thorized and empowered to raise and appropriate at any
- 3 regular or special town meeting duly called and held after
- 4 this act goes into effect, a sum not exceeding two thousand
- 5 five hundred dollars for the purpose of paying for a clock
- 6 tower in said town, and the action of said town in voting
- 7 to build said clock tower is hereby made legal and valid.
