STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-three of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to the Salary of the Register of Deeds for the County of Androscoggin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The first paragraph of section forty-three of the public

- 2 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby amended by
- 3 striking out the words "fifteen hundred dollars" in said first
- 4 paragraph of said section forty-three and substituting there-

5 for the words 'two thousand dollars,' so that said first para-6 graph of said section, as amended, shall read as follows: 'Androscoggin, two thousand dollars.'
