AN ACT to Amend the Second Paragraph of Section Forty-five of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter One Hundred Fifty-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to Clerk Hire in the Androscoggin County Registry of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The second paragraph of section forty-five of chapter one hundred seventeen of the revised statutes as amended by

3 chapter one hundred fifty-three of the public laws of nine-
4 teen hundred seventeen as amended by chapter two hun-
5 dred nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred twen-
6 ty-one is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen
7 hundred dollars" in said second paragraph of said section
8 forty-five and substituting therefor the words 'twenty-three
9 hundred dollars,' so that said second paragraph of said sec-
10 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Androscoggin county, for clerk's hire in the registry of
2 deeds, twenty-three hundred dollars.

'For clerk's hire in the office of registry of probate, one
2 thousand and forty dollars.

'For clerk's hire in the office of clerk of court, seven hun-
2 dred and eighty dollars.'
