STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Paragraph Numbered One Under Section One, Chapter Seventy-six of the Revised Statutes of Maine, Relative to Granting of Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That paragraph numbered one under section one, chapter 2 seventy-six of the revised statutes of Maine, relative to 3 granting of licenses, is hereby amended by inserting the 4 words 'funeral charges' after the word "debts" in the third 5 line of said paragraph one, and by striking out the word 6 "and" after the word "legacies" in the said third line and 7 adding after the word "administration" in said third line 8 'and for the erection of a suitable marker or gravestone,'

9 so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. Sale, lease or exchange of real estate, when
2 to be licensed. Judges of probate, in the counties where
3 the applicants hereinafter named were appointed, may
4 license the sale, lease or exchange of real estate and any
5 interests therein, in whatever county situated, in the fol-
6 lowing cases, on application:

‘I. Of executors and administrators, including public ad-
2 ministrators, for power to sell so much of such estate of
3 the deceased as is necessary to pay debts, funeral charges,
4 legacies, expenses of sale and administration and for the
5 erection of a suitable marker or gravestone.’
