STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Sixteen, Private
and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Eleven, Relating to
Incorporation of Parsonsfield Kezar Falls Village Corpo-
ration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter two hundred sixteen, private and
2 special laws of nineteen hundred eleven, is hereby amended
3 by striking out the word "and" following the word "side-
4 walks" in the third line, and by adding after the word
5 "sewers" in the fourth line, the words 'public libraries,
6 school houses, and other necessary public buildings, and
7 public parks, and for the protection of trees and shrubs

8 from the ravages of insects,' so that said section, as amend-
9 ed, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Said corporation shall in like manner have power
2 to raise money for the lighting of streets, the maintenance
3 of streets, the building and maintenance of sidewalks, the
4 building and maintenance of a system of drains and sewers,
5 public libraries, school houses and other necessary public
6 buildings, and public parks, and for the protection of trees
7 and shrubs from the ravages of insects.'
