STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Twenty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to Clerk Hire in the Lewiston Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
P. & S. L., 1921, c. 128; relating to clerk hire of the Lewis2 ton municipal court, amended. Chapter one hundred and
3 twenty-eight of the private and special laws of nineteen
4 hundred and twelve is hereby amended by striking out the
5 words "seven hundred and eighty" in the second and third
6 lines of section one, and inserting in place thereof, the words
7 'ten hundred and forty.'

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'Section I. The amount allowed for clerk hire increased. 2 The clerk of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston 3 shall receive an annual salary of eighteen hundred dollars, 4 with ten hundred and forty dollars additional for clerk hire 5 from said city in monthly payments, which sum shall be 6 in full compensation for the performance of all duties re-7 quired of said clerk by law. He shall account quarterly 8 under oath, to wit, on the first days of January, April, July 9 and October of each year, to the treasurer of the city of 10 Lewiston for all fees received by him by virtue of his office, 11 specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of 12 the same to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston, quarterly 13 on the days aforesaid.'

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
