#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Nine of Chapter One Hundred Forty-three of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to the Lewiston City Auditor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Section nine of chapter one hundred forty-three of the

- 2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "city" in the
- 4 third line thereof the following words, namely:

"by the commission, board of trustees, department or 2 agency of which he is a member, or by himself as member 3 of such commission, trustee, head of department, agent, or 4 holder of a place of trust.'

So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. City officers not to be pecuniarily interested in 2 city contracts; penalty for receiving secret discounts on city 3 contracts. No member of a commission, trustee, heads of 4 departments, agent or other person holding a place of trust 5 in the city, shall be pecuniarily interested directly or in-6 directly in any contracts made in behalf of the city, by the 7 commission, board of trustees, department or agency of 8 which he is a member or by himself as member of such 9 commission, trustee, head of department, agent, or holder of 10 a place of trust, and any violation thereof is void and shall II not be approved by said auditor; and if any such officer or 12 person receives any drawbacks, presents, gratuities, or secret 13 discounts to his own use on account of such contracts, or 14 from the profits in any materials, supplies or labor, furn-15 ished or done for the city, he shall upon conviction be fined 16 not less than two hundred dollars, and imprisoned for not 17 less than three months.'
